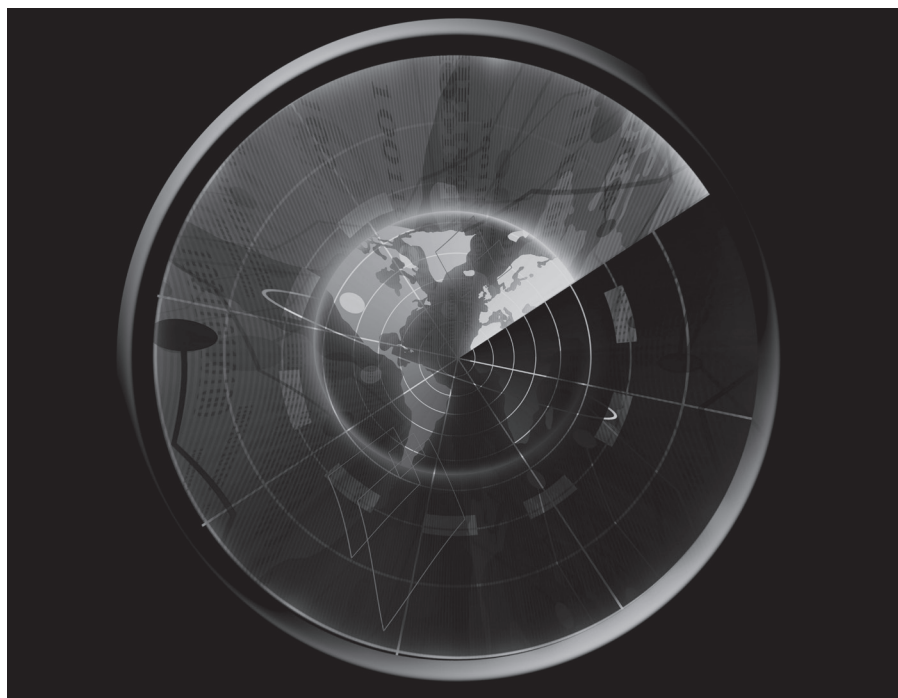


Training Support and Analysis: Joint and Combined Arms Training

'Joint' warfare can be described as integrated military operations involving forces drawn from two or more services e.g. Army, Navy, Air Force or allied countries. When forces come together as part of a Joint operation they will normally act under one unified command rather than acting separately.

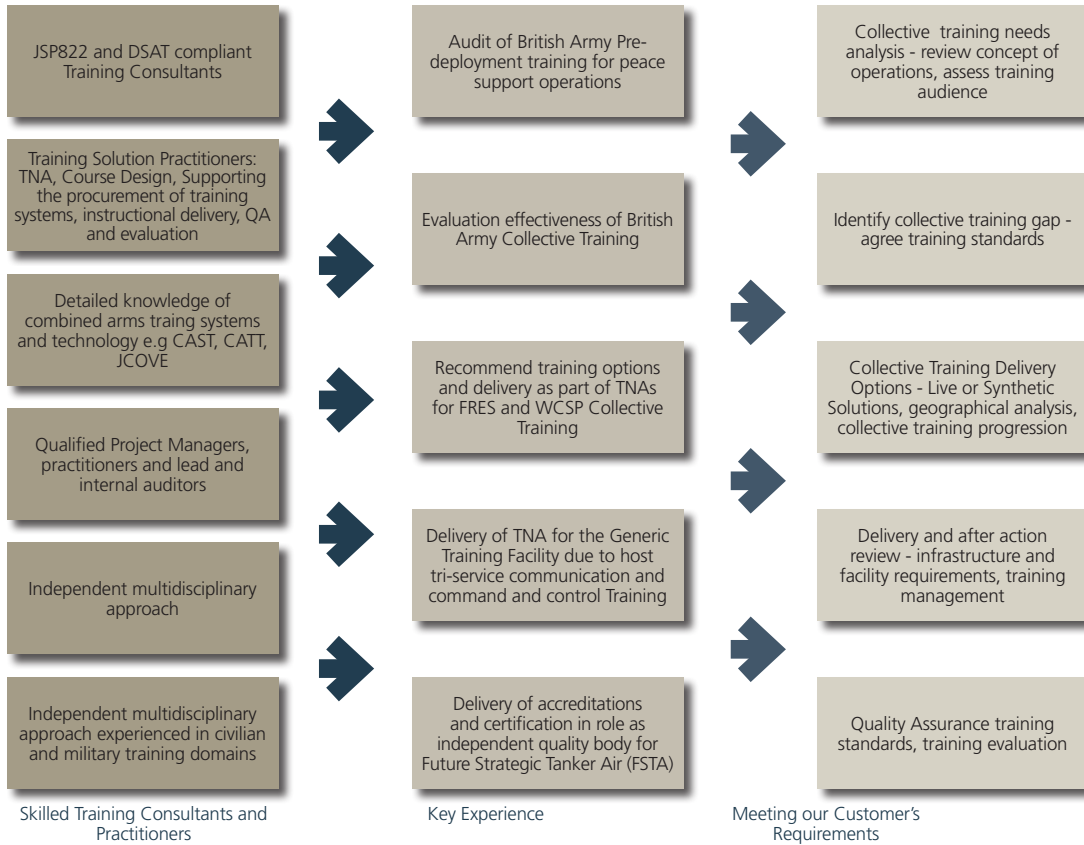
Combined Arms Training and Tactics

'Combined Arms' is an approach to warfare which seeks to integrate 2 or more arms or elements of a military service to achieve mutually complementary effects e.g. Infantry, Armour, Artillery.
